Page 4: Under **Winter Quarter 2013** replace **Registration** with Registration for Spring Quarter 2013

Page 6: Under **ACCREDITATIONS** add Globe University – Appleton to **ABHES** approvals.

Page 10: Under **ADMISSION STANDARDS** remove the paragraph immediately following the paragraph beginning with, “Writing.”

Page 12: Under **ASSESSMENT TESTING AND ACCUPLACER RESULTS** replace sentence skills and arithmetic with the following:

Sentence Skills, a student must

--Place into college-level English composition, CM121, with an Accuplacer score of 87 or greater, or have completed an equivalent course

--Previous GEN graduates who have completed foundational requirements are recommended to successfully complete Composition in the first quarter of Nursing enrollment.

Arithmetic, a student must

--Place into college-level algebra, NS116, with an Accuplacer score of 87 or greater, or have completed an equivalent course

--Previous GEN graduates who have completed foundational requirements are recommended to successfully complete College Algebra in the first quarter of Nursing enrollment.

Page 55: Remove **Madison East** from offering the **Associates of Applied Science Interactive Media and Graphic Design**.
