### OBJECTIVES

The objective of this program is to provide students with a thorough understanding of Digital Video Editing, Scripting, Storyboarding, Motion Graphics, Sound, Lighting and DVD Design and Authoring, with an emphasis on the skill needed to prepare the students for entry-level employment as: Digital Video Editor, Scriptwriter, Storyboard Artist, Motion Graphic Developer, Sound Assistant, Lighting Assistant, and DVD Designer or Production Developer. This program provides evidence of competencies in communications, social sciences, humanities and fine arts, analytical and inferential reasoning, and computational skills as well as the ability to learn on one's own.
